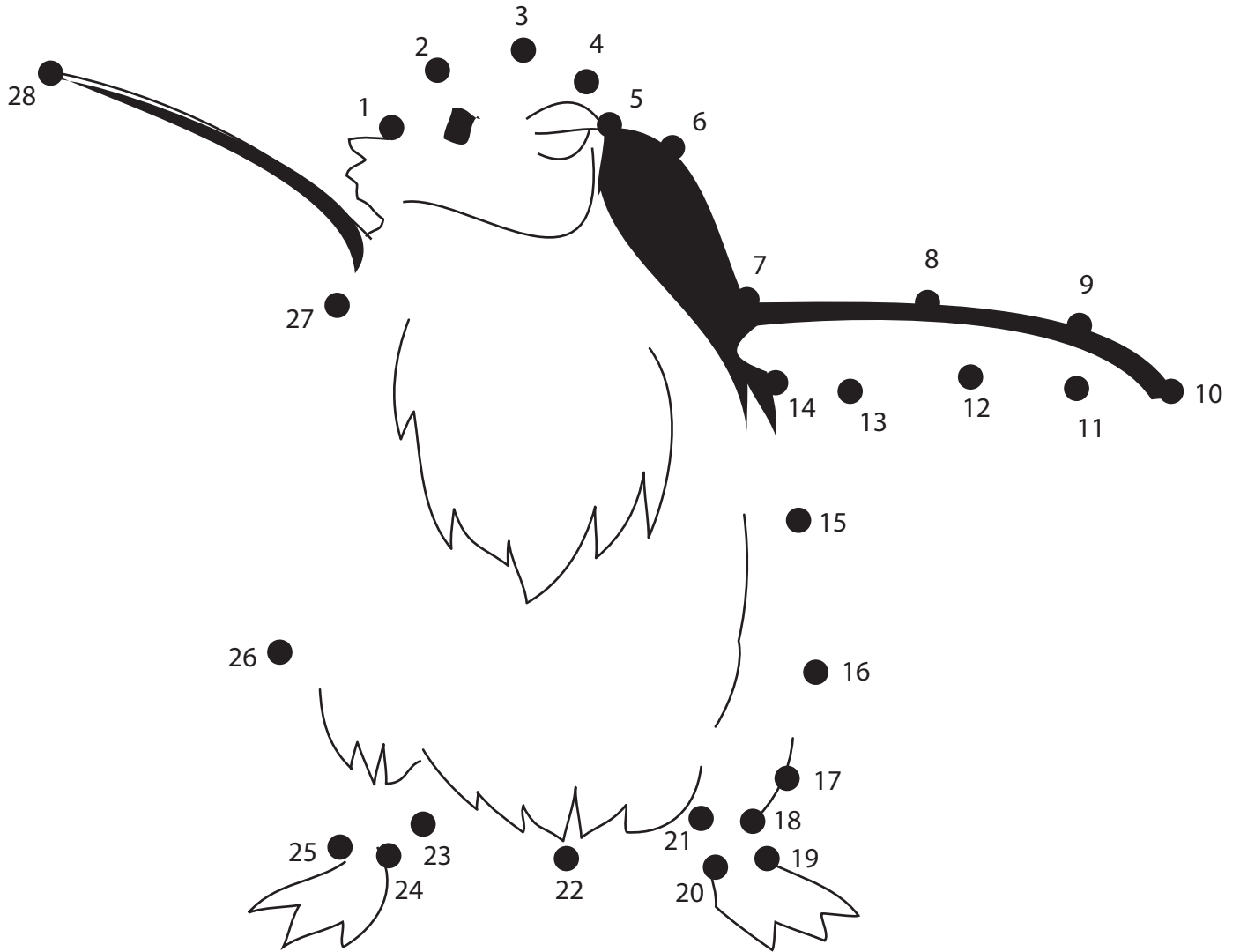




Connect the dots.

Penguins

Many people are surprised to learn, also, that the daddy penguins do a lot of the caring for the little penguin chicks. When a penguin chick hatches, the mother penguin goes off to look for food, leaving the baby with its father – often for weeks.
